Privileges, Exemptions, and Immunities: International Organization or Foreign Government Employee Providing Aid in Another Jurisdiction

43 MIRC 308

Other medical professional, Volunteer / Other, Nurse, Physician, EMT, Government Public Health, Firefighter, Law Enforcement, Veterinarian, Dentist, Pharmacist, Social Worker, Mental and Behavioral Health Professional, Minor/Student

An individual, who is an employee of an international organization or foreign government, will have the same privileges, exemptions, and immunities from being held legally responsible while working in their official capacity in the Marshall Islands as they do while working in their official capacity elsewhere.

Good Samaritan Law

19 MIRC 626

Other medical professional, Volunteer / Other, Nurse, Physician, EMT, Government Public Health, Firefighter, Law Enforcement, Veterinarian, Dentist, Pharmacist, Social Worker, Mental and Behavioral Health Professional, Minor/Student

An individual, who, in good faith, provides emergency care at the scene of an emergency, will not be held legally responsible for acting or for failing to act. They can be held legally responsible if acting with extreme carelessness or intent to cause harm.

Generally, Good Samaritan laws only offer protection for those individuals who provide care during spontaneous emergencies unrelated to volunteer deployment.

This section does not apply to care provided inside a health care facility.

Liability: Reporting Communicable Disease

7 MIRC 1505

An individual, who, in good faith, reports a person suspected of being infected with a communicable disease, will not be held legally responsible for making the report.

Temporary License: Medical Team Member

19 MIRC 615

An individual, who is part of a medical team providing health care services, can obtain a short-term license to provide medical services for a week or a month by submitting credentials to the Marshall Islands? Secretary of Health.
