

License Reciprocity: Physical Therapist

ARS 32-2021(C)(5)

A physical therapist licensed in another jurisdiction of the U.S. can provide physical therapy in Arizona to victims of a declared local, state, or national disaster or emergency for the duration of the emergency but no longer than 60 days. The nonresident physical therapist must register with the Arizona Board of Physical Therapy.

Persons & activities not required to be licensed

5. A physical therapist who is licensed in another jurisdiction of the United States and who enters this state to provide physical therapy to victims of a declared local, state or national disaster or emergency. This exemption applies for the duration of the declared emergency but not longer than sixty days. The physical therapist must also register with the board before practicing.
