

# **Powers, Duties, Rights, Privileges, and Immunities: Political Subdivision Employees Providing Aid in Another Jurisdiction**

## **OCGA 38-3-30**

An employee of a political subdivision who provides emergency management aid outside of their home jurisdiction will receive the same powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities as if they were in their home jurisdiction.

---

### **Aid rendered by local employees to other political subdivisions; reimbursement of personnel and equipment expenses by aided locality; procedure**

(a) Whenever the employees of any political subdivision are rendering outside aid pursuant to the authority contained in Code Section 38-3-27, the employees shall have the same powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities as if they were performing their duties in the political subdivisions in which they are normally employed.
