

License Reciprocity: Emergency Responder

Burns ind. Code Ann. 10-14-6.5-5

An out-of-state licensed, certified, or permitted emergency responder, who provides aid related to their license, certificate, or permit and within their scope of practice, will be considered licensed, certified, or permitted in Indiana.

The emergency responder's aid must be requested per a mutual aid agreement.

Emergency responder holding license, certificate, or other permit recognized or issued by another state

If an emergency responder from a jurisdiction outside Indiana holds a license, certificate, or other permit recognized or issued by another state, that emergency responder is considered to be licensed, certified, and permitted in Indiana to render aid involving such skill to meet the request for assistance under a mutual aid agreement under this chapter, so long as the emergency responder acts within the scope of:

- (1) the emergency responder's license, certificate, or permit; and
- (2) what would be authorized by an equivalent license, certificate, or permit from or recognized by the state in which the requesting jurisdiction is located.
